I recently noted, and others have shared with me, that there has been a large increase in communications that display disrespectful attributes. Your Board voted and signed a contract for property management with East to West Property Management. We all thank Doug Wiley for supporting our HOA. The company is very excited about supporting the HOA and providing excellent service. Please welcome Lauren to the Property Manager position.

Voting in Heron River: Our HOA's annual elections are coming up in weeks. It is important for all homeowners to know that we must reach a quorum to continue the meeting. Each meeting costs over \$2,000 in room rental fees, voting support, and mailing fees. If we don't reach a quorum, we must do the entire process over again and spend additional HOA funds to cover a second meeting. For this reason, we ask all homeowners to either vote or fill out a proxy for someone else to vote for you.

There are lots of great things happening in the neighborhood. We have new restaurants coming to Star; the mayor is getting the historic bridge installed by River House, and the contractors are completing the driveway from Breakwater Avenue into the new park. Soon, work will begin on completing the frisbee golf park.

The HOA wants to thank our many volunteers, who, without them, would be forced to outsource many of the functions they perform. They are a critical piece of Heron River, and in keeping up with the amount of work it takes to maintain nearly a hundred acres, the Community Center, pool, irrigation system, lighting systems, basketball, tennis, and pickleball courts, to name a few. Not all of these are covered by vendor contracts and are dealt with on an as-needed basis. Using volunteers negates the need for vendors to do all of the work. <u>Heron River Landscape Committee - 2025 Season Update</u>

The Landscape Committee is excited to kick off the 2025 season!

If you're unfamiliar with our role, the Landscape Committee is composed of section captains, each responsible for a different area of our community. These captains regularly report to the Committee Chair, helping to keep an eye on landscaping needs. While they may not catch everything, their role serves as an important checks-and-balances system between the HOA Board, homeowners, and our property management team. This ensures that landscaping concerns are reported, prioritized, and scheduled for maintenance or improvements.

Prioritizing Projects

While all landscaping concerns are important, not everything is urgent, and not all requests can be addressed immediately. Several factors influence the completion timeline, including budget, urgency, vendor availability, and the time of year.

For 2025, we have a mix of committee-led projects and HOA budgeted landscape improvements in the works:



COMMITTEE-LED PROJECTS

1. Tree Mapping Project

The committee is actively mapping all trees in our common areas. Instead of hiring an outside contractor, we are fortunate to have two knowledgeable community members, K. Grundel and M. Fraser, who have volunteered their expertise to complete this important project.

2. Spring Beautification – Flowers & More

Over the next few months, you'll notice more color at Heron River's main entrances!

The Spring Beautification Refresh TEAM is working within a modest 2025 budget to add seasonal flowers and enhancements that will brighten up our community.

HOA LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENT PLANS 2025

Drip Line Tune-Up - Meadows Section

Keeping our plants happy and hydrated is a top priority! The drip system in the Meadows has had some trouble spots and had to be cut in several areas in 2024 when the root collar excavation took place. This spring, we'll be fixing leaks, replacing damaged lines, and making sure everything is working efficiently to keep our trees, shrubs, and green spaces thriving.



Tree TLC - Community-Wide

Some of our trees are overdue for a little extra care! In addition to regular pruning, we'll be giving special attention to older, overgrown trees that need a refresh. This will help improve their health, visibility, and overall safety throughout Heron River.



Fence Refresh - Waterview & Preserve

Time for a touch-up! Some fencing in the Waterview and Preserve neighborhoods will be getting a fresh coat of stain to extend its life, keep it looking great, and maintain the community's polished look.





Out with the Old, In with the New – Tree Replacements

We're saying goodbye to dead trees and stumps throughout the neighborhood. Replacements will happen as budget allows in 2025, ensuring Heron River stays lush and beautifully landscaped.

Architectural Design Committee

We have received 5 Architectural Design Requests since Jan 1st. 3 have been approved and 2 are being discussed, modifications required, and/or more info is needed to review.

ADC is looking for more people to join the committee.

We are working diligently to get the pending ADC requests reviewed and through the approval process. It's important to note that all residents need to submit a ADC Request Form for any changes being made to their yard, paint, house, etc. We are working with the Association Board, and Management Company to make sure that all requests are in compliance with the Architectural Guidelines set forth by the Developer, as outlined in the CC&R's.

Failure to comply with HOA guidelines and the ADC review process complicates the process and will delay your project.
